Short description of the project, including its aims	The main idea of the project is organizing a weeklong meeting of teenagers from diverse environments (planned for August 2016) from Poland and two partner countries. Tolerance, multiculturalism and problems specific to rural areas around Golczewo (e.g. gender equality, effects of unemployment, the relationship of youth and seniors) are going to be a main theme of the meeting. During this week, all participants will take part in general development workshop. Afterwards, they will be divided into three specialized groups: 1. ETHNO TEAM – will take part in ethnographic workshop to create sensitivity for cultural diversity. Etno Team will prepare creative research for understanding chosen problem of the local community (interviews, etc.). Results of research will support MOVIE TEAM and MEDIA TEAM. 2. MOVIE TEAM – participants will work on creating movie-	
	scripts, editing of a movie workshops. In cooperation with two other groups, MOVIE TEAM will prepare documentary movie illustrating the social theme taken up by the whole group.	



	3. MEDIA TEAM - journalism/social media workshop (to gain practical skills but also to get familiar with various internet tools). MEDIA TEAM will create blog website describing creative process during the meeting. MEDIA TEAM will take care about promotion of the project and will provide information and news for everyone.
	All groups will cooperate together. Teams will consist of representation of all nationalities taking part in the project. All activities during the weeklong meeting will be topped out with a final event, which will present the effects of works and sum up the whole project. All the interested people will be invited (especially those working with youth and the inhabitants of the region) The movie made by MOVIE TEAM will be displayed, the exhibition of photographs will be presented as well as the observations of the ETHNO TEAM.
	Cooperation WITH PARTNER TOWNS We would like to invite 30 participants from 2 partner towns (15 people from each one). Since the program demands own contribution, not necessarily financial one, we would suggest following solution: Golczewo, as the leader of the project would be responsible for organizing of the whole endeavor, putting together an application and submitting it, as well as for recruiting the volunteers. Your town, as a partner of the project, would be handling the recruitment of adolescents from your town, providing people responsible for a group (caretakers) and covering the costs of transportation of your group. All the other costs will be covered by the money from the project. We hope this proposal is suitable for you. If you have any other proposals don't hesitate to discuss it with us - we are open for any suggestions
