Short description of the organization	<p>Năsăud is a town in Bistrița-Năsăud county, north of Romania, located in the historical region of Transylvania. The town administrates two villages, Liviu Rebreanu and Lușca. The region is famous all over the world because of the legend of Count Dracula and for Rodna Mountains National Park which is one of the three Biosphere Reserves of Romania. We consider that the region has far more interesting things to promote than a legend and we want to make people from other countries to discover these things, and also to encourage our citizens to promote true values and traditions of the place in the whole world.</p> <p>The municipality of Năsăud is more and more concerned of involving its citizens in projects and activities that can contribute to their own development and to the development of our region. This is why we consider that Europe for Citizens is the proper opportunity to make them realize the importance of active involvement in community's life and also in European life in general.</p> <p>As far as it concerns the experience within international projects, we can mention four twinning projects within "Europe for Citizens" Programme, with four towns of Europe (Mandello del Lario – Italy, Mława – Poland, Alexandria – Greece and Kavadarci – FYROM) and one networking project with seven European partners (Mandello del Lario – Italy, Mława – Poland, Alexandria – Greece, Kavadarci – FYROM, Kekava – Latvia, Lefkara – Cyprus and Nasaud – Romania). We have also implemented six youth projects within the "Youth in Action" Programme. We are increasingly concerned to involve citizens in various european projects and activities that can contribute to their own development and to the development of our region.</p>

Short description of the project (aims, objectives, main activities, venue)	<p>The project “Solidarity without Borders” will involve 7 partners from 7 different European countries. The project will last for 24 month and will consist of 7 citizen’s meetings . One meeting will be maximum of 6 days. The countries (towns) involved will be: Romania (Nasaud) - as applicant , Poland (Mlawa), Italy (Mandello del Lario), Croatia (Split) Malta (Swiqui) and Portugal (Setubal). I am still looking for one more partner. I want to mention that Nasaud (Romania) is in twinning with Mlawa (Poland) and Mandello del Lario (Italy) since 2009.</p> <p>We intend to make a meeting in each country involved in the project. The goal of this project aims to the citizens solidarity spirit in order to solve a social problem in each of the seven communities involved. Through this project, we intend to organize at the end of each event a charitable action that will be in favor of a certain social cause. For example in Nasaud (Romania) we would like to host a charitable action like a stage performance which will involve at least all the 70 citizens, participants at this project. What I have in mind is a theatre show for example in which you will be the actors and the spectators will make a small donation, at the end. We will also talk to the local business enterprises, in order to get some sponsorships which will go to the ones in need. I have not identified yet the persons, but I have in mind the abandoned children from the orphanage. This is one example, but I am also having in mind the elder persons, who live a harsh life, some of which are unable to care for themselves. These are just some examples, from our community. I am certain that you can think of at least one social case from your local community, to whom the general idea of this project can be of help. I would like to have a new approach concerning this new project. Unlike the previous ones, I would like this one to be a project with more action and less talk. Meaning that there will be far more few meetings and discussions and more focus on solving the social problem identified. I would really love to see that we have some tangible results in the life of the citizens of our community and to see that at least one life was changed in each community thanks to this project. I would like to point out that I intend to gather a certain amount of money from the charitable actions we will perform and give this money directly to the ones in need.</p> <p>I have talked with the Romanian branch representatives of the Europe for Citizens program and this idea is possible, and it has their approval. They proposed the following financial solution: The money raised will be deposited in the project’s account and from there acquisitions will be made for those in need.</p> <p>For each event we foreseen the participation of 70 people: 10 from each local community . The budget of the project covers the costs of transport to the other countries and the organisation of event. Each municipality will have a small part of cofinanciation.</p>

	<p>Your task in this project will be to help me to make the daily programme of the event from your town, as you know what can be done there. You will host one of the events, for which you will receive the money according to the budget. From that money you will have to arrange the three daily meals, the accommodation for the foreigners and the activities of the project. As you know the mechanism of these projects first you have to give the money from your local budget then on the base of invoices the EU gives the money back for the project. I also want to mention that we can make changes. We can change dates, number of participants, days</p>
